When submitting any of the documents below, be sure they meet the <u>requirements for acceptance</u>.

Required Documents

Except when a child is homeless, the state requires schools to gather the following information before enrolling the child and allowing them to attend school.

Parent Proof of Residence	 Driver's License/Department of Transportation ID (preferred) Current utility bill (dated within the last 30 days) Deed All pages of a current lease Property tax bill Both vehicle insurance and registration
Student Proof of Age	Child's birth certificateChild's valid passportChild's baptismal certificate with seal
Student Immunization Record	• Please see <u>PA state-mandated</u> <u>Immunization Requirements</u> .

Requested Academic Records

Many of these documents can be downloaded from a school portal or obtained from your child's school.*

- · Most Recent School-issued Report Card
- High School Transcripts (grades 9-12 only)
- Current Attendance Record
- Current Disciplinary Report
- 504 Plan

Requested Homeschool Documents (If applicable)

These documents apply only to children who have been traditionally homeschooling.

- Most Recent Homeschool Affidavit (notarized)
- Most Recent Homeschool Evaluation

Requested Special Education Records or Gifted Records (If applicable)

These documents can be obtained from your child's school.

- Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- Evaluation Report (ER)
- Notification of Recommended Educational Placement (NOREP)
- Gifted Individualized Education Plan (GIEP)
- Gifted Written Report (GWR)
- Notification of Recommended Assignment (NORA)

If your child has been exited from Special Education Services or Gifted Services, please submit an exit-NOREP or exit-NORA.

Requested Custodial Documents (If applicable)

- Court-issued Custody Agreement
- · Court-issued Guardian Document
