

Sample Weekly Plan for a Synchronous Tenth Grade Student

Most students have a combination of both SYNC and ASYNC classes, and each grade level has prescribed or required courses.

SYNC (Synchronous) - Students attend live classes in the virtual classroom with teacher and peers.

ASYNC (Asynchronous) - The Learning Coach chooses when the student completes each subject during the school day using the curriculum and online resources provided. Students do not attend daily live classes, however coursework is planned and supervised by their teacher.
