

Sample Weekly Plan for a Synchronous Second Grade Student

Synchronous students have a combination of both SYNC and ASYNC classes.

SYNC (Synchronous) - Certified teachers instruct students in a live online class setting Monday through Thursday.

ASync (Asynchronous) - Coursework is planned and supervised by a certified teacher. The Learning Coach implements the teacher's plan using the provided curriculum & online resources to instruct their child(ren) on a daily basis. While class instruction is highly suggested to be completed during daylight hours, there is flexibility for the Learning Coach to choose when each subject is completed.

*LAB - Teachers use this time to help students fill gaps, reinforce skills, or enrich students with Math and/or Reading lessons. At times, this time may also be used for writing and/or to complete screenings. At times, LAB time groups are smaller groups & may be based upon specific skills that multiple students may need further direction or understanding.

^BOOST (Building On Our Skills Together) - Teachers use this time for fun, "hands-on" educational purposes that provide students with discovery-based learning, interactive learning activities, assemblies, science labs, project-based learning, or other types of activities where students may use skills, knowledge, & content gained from other course instruction as background knowledge.

ASync and Guided Coursework

Coursework is planned and supervised by the teacher. Students use this time to complete assignments which may include work in workbooks, academic software and e-learning programs, offline projects, writing practice, and more.
